

Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology

Monthly Achievements for the month of September, 2025

The significant developments pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of September, 2025 are as given below:

1. Electronics Manufacturing

(i) Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem in India

As of September 2025, following applications have been approved under the scheme:

- One (1) application for providing fiscal support for setting up a Semiconductor Fab facility in India.
- Eight (8) applications have been approved for setting up of Semiconductor ATMP/OSAT facilities in India.
- One (1) application have been approved for setting up of Compound fab facility in India.
- Twenty-three (23) applications have been approved for providing fiscal support for Semiconductor Design companies under Design Linked incentive scheme.

(ii) Modified Special Incentives Package Scheme (M-SIPS)

- Incentives amounting Rs 27.86 crore has been disbursed to 5 applicants.

(iii) Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLI) for IT Hardware:

- Till September 2025, PLI Schemes for IT Hardware have led to a total cumulative production of Rs. 14,462.7 crore, total cumulative investment of Rs. 892.47 crore and total cumulative employment of 6,821 (direct jobs).

(iv) Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS)

- As on September 2025, Rs. 720.36 crore has been disbursed to 22 applicants.

(v) Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLI) for LSEM

- Till September 2025, PLI Schemes for LSEM have led to a total cumulative production of Rs. 9,34,107 crore, total cumulative investment of Rs. 13,759.44 crore and total cumulative employment of 1,36,524 (direct jobs).

(vi) Electronics Manufacturing Clusters (EMC) & EMC 2.0 Scheme

- Under EMC 2.0 scheme, An EMC project was approved at TP 2A, Activation Area, Dholera SIR, Gujarat to Project Implementing Agency (PIA) i.e., M/s. Dholera Industrial City Development Limited (DICDL)). This EMC is projected to attract an investment of Rs. 99,160 Crores (including the anchor unit commitment of over Rs. 91,000 crores), and pose to generate an employment of a total: 28,787 jobs (incl. anchor unit commitment of 20,000 jobs).

- Under EMC 2.0 scheme, at EMC Dharwad, Karnataka, an anchor unit M/s. Nidec Industrial Automation India Pvt. Ltd, has been allotted land with incremental investment of about Rs. 100 crores and provided employment to approx. 200 persons.

2. Minimum Government, Maximum Governance

- (i). **Jeevan Pramaan:** A total of 4,06,585 Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) have been generated in September, 2025.
- (ii). **MyGov:** Till September 2025, MyGov has 1036 discussion themes and 1824 tasks. Around 5.93 Crore people have registered on the Platform.
- (iii). **Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India:** Till September 2025, more than 4.81 lakh resources have been contributed under 12,538 catalogs and 3,545 Visualizations and 2,36,184 Datasets APIs have been created. 1,11,60,983 datasets have been downloaded.
