

**Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology**  
**Monthly Achievements for the month of February, 2026**

The significant developments pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of February, 2026 are as given below:

**1. Electronics Manufacturing**

**(i) Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem in India**

As of February 2026, following applications have been approved under the scheme:

- One (1) application for providing fiscal support for setting up a Semiconductor Fab facility in India.
- Eight (8) applications have been approved for setting up of Semiconductor ATMP/OSAT facilities in India.
- One (1) application have been approved for setting up of Compound fab facility in India.
- Twenty-four (24) applications have been approved for providing fiscal support for Semiconductor Design companies under Design Linked incentive scheme.

**(ii) Modified Special Incentives Package Scheme (M-SIPS)**

Incentives amounting Rs 19.89 crore has been disbursed to 3 applicants.

**(iii) Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLI) for IT Hardware:**

Till February 2026, PLI Schemes for IT Hardware have led to a total cumulative production of Rs. 18,863.11 crore, total cumulative investment of Rs. 872.16 crore and total cumulative employment of 5,039 (direct jobs).

**(iv) Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS)**

As of February 2026, Rs. 806.49 crore has been disbursed to 28 applicants.

**(v) Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLI) for LSEM**

Till February 2026, PLI Schemes for LSEM have led to a total cumulative production of Rs. 11,01,813 crore, total cumulative investment of Rs. 17,519 crore and total cumulative employment of 1,85,175.

## 2. Minimum Government, Maximum Governance

- (i) **Jeevan Pramaan:** A total of 5,75,155 Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) have been generated in February 2026.
- (ii) **MyGov:** Till February 2026, MyGov has 1052 discussions and 1883 tasks. Around 6.10 Crore people have registered on the Platform.
- (iii) **Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India:** Till February 2026, more than 4.54 lakh resources have been contributed under 12,613 catalogs. 3,667 Visualizations and 2,36,593 Datasets APIs have been created 1,16,26,501 datasets have been downloaded.
